Q. How do I find out about booking?

Q. Who deals with my enquiries?

A. The On The Fringe team will aim to get back to any enquiries as quickly as we can, we rely on both part time staff and volunteers to respond, so please be patient if it takes a few days for us to get back to you

Q. What is the capacity of On The Fringe?

A. Currently we have conservatively estimated the attendance figures below, however we're open to your feedback and we may revise these figures

Q. How much does the venue cost to book?

A. We have looked at the prices of both community run and commercial venues and developed a fair pricing structure with different rates for different uses and different clients. All the prices can be found [here](#).

Q. Why are there hire prices?

A. A lot of people think Southside Fringe runs on funding, we don't. We've been a volunteer run, self funded festival since 2013. We received some funding from Unltd Scotland to refurbish the unit for your use, but we need to cover the costs of running the unit, this includes the all bills, insurances and staff costs.

Q. Can I bring in my own equipment?

A. Yes, but please make sure you read our [External Equipment Policy](#). We also have our own range of equipment you can use. Some items are part of the hire fee and others carry

Q. Are you a licensed premises?

A. No, we are unlicensed premises but for some events we do operate a BYOB policy and for others we can discuss the possibility of occasional licenses. Whilst we want folks to enjoy themselves, we have a social responsibility to our community and for BYOB nights we've introduced a [Responsible Alcohol Policy](#). If you would like to have alcohol at your event, it is important you read and agree to this policy.
