



RESPONSIBLE ALCOHOL POLICY - 2019

We are an unlicensed premises. We operate a BYOB policy for some events and we can discuss occasional licenses for events also. Whilst we want folks to enjoy themselves, we want to encourage responsible drinking practises. Any events or activities in On The Fringe will be subject to a responsible drinking and alcohol policy. It is part of the terms of the hire that you read, understand and agree to the terms set out below at your event.

We are trialling this policy from February 2019, and it will be subject to a 3 monthly review by the Festival Director. Your feedback is welcome.



In the case of an event organiser hosting a BYOB event:

- On arrival guests and performers will be required to hand over their alcohol or soft drinks over to the fringe team member at the counter.
- Guests will be aged checked in keeping with Challenge 25 and verified with a fringe stamp
- Any alcohol brought in will be handed over at the reception counter and guest will be allocated a ticket

- A correlating ticket will be attached to the alcohol
- Alcohol will be stored behind the reception counter
- Plastic glasses or similar will be provided for a £1 deposit
- Guests may bring their own drinking cups if preferred
- No alcohol containers, tins, bottles etc to be taken in to the event
- Upon return of your cup, your £1 deposit will be repaid and on presentation of

- your ticket any remaining alcohol will given back to take home
- Anyone thought to be not drinking responsibly will be refused further alcohol and offered a soft drink alternative
- Any guests or performers who object or cause a scene will be asked to leave the premises and invited to return to claim their alcohol when sober
